

CHÂTEAU POUMEY

The origin of Château Poumey dates back to 1720. It was owned by Jeanne-Thérèse de Pomiers, whose husband was a squire and advisor to the King. The current building was constructed by an English merchant settled in Bordeaux, René Alfred Morton. He restored the vineyard in 1871. In 1988, the town of Gradignan acquired Château Poumey, the last wine estate in the municipality. In 1995, it entrusted the operation to Château Pape Clément, a classified growth of Graves.

Since 2020, Domaine de Chevalier, a Classified Growth of Graves in Léognan, has been entrusted by the town of Gradignan with the responsibility for managing this estate. Olivier Bernard's dual objective is to reestablish the history and wines of Château Poumey within the community of Gradignan and to practice environmentally respectful viticulture. A commitment has been made to convert to organic farming.

<u>VINEYARD AND WINEMAKING</u> A.O.C. : PESSAC-LEOGNAN <u>Surface area</u>: Red: 10,5 ha - White: 1,5 ha soon in production Gravelly soils over clay subsoil

Red vines :

50 % cabernet sauvignon - 50 % merlot

Hand-harvesting with selective sorting in the vineyard and at the winery. Bunches carried in small crates Sorting tables (manual and optical). Vinification in concrete temperature-controlled vats. Aging in French oak barrels, for 16 months.

The deep and intense black color of the robe showcases the concentration and richness of the vintage. A profound intensity of ripe black fruits intertwines harmoniously with spicy and floral notes, creating a seductive complexity. This wine possesses a captivating aromatic profile.

On the palate, the wine is supple, powerful, and well-structured, with an exquisite tannic framework. It offers a velvety texture and a full-bodied, generous mouthfeel.

While enjoyable in its youth, the Château Poumey 2022 undoubtedly has significant aging potential. Years spent in the cellar will reveal refined elegance and subtle complexity.

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
